Carpet Tile Recovery Take Back Service





Carpet tiles are checked and sorted to identify optimum recycling route



Since 2022, none of our waste, including carpet tiles returned using our recovery take back service, are disposed via landfill.



Reuse

Working with our partners and community organisations, wherever possible, carpet tiles are reused



Our recovery take back service is available on schemes of 100m² or more, where you are refurbishing with Burmatex[®] carpet tiles. Costs start from £85 per pallet*

* Price is subject to geographical location and site access



Step 2:

Follow our packaging guide on how to palletise your used tiles

Packaging Guide

- For safety reasons, tiles should be stacked neatly on pallets, no more than 1.3 metres high (above the pallet).
- All pallets should be shrink-wrapped.
- Boxed tiles and loose full tiles should be stacked on separate pallets.
- Off cuts should be placed in bags on separate pallets.
- Burmatex® can supply pallets/packaging material if required (additional costs will apply).



Step 3:

Once your used tiles are ready for collection, simply contact us at **recovery@burmatex.co.uk** and we will arrange their return

Frequently Asked Questions

Is it only Burmatex® carpet tiles you take back?

Where you are replacing the flooring with Burmatex® carpet tiles, we will take back any manufacturers carpet tiles.

Do you take back LVT?

Our current service covers carpet tiles only. We hope in the future to be able to take back other forms of flooring.

Do you take back carpet tiles even if we are not using your products?

At the moment our service is offered on projects where our carpet tiles are being fitted.

Do you take back any form of carpet tile backing?

Our service covers bitumen, cushion/acoustic back, and polyolefin backings.

Due to the environmental impact we do not offer this service on PVC backed carpet tiles.
